Phase 1 Improvements – East End

- Plaza area along Granby / Open usable pedestrian space / Multi-use attractive space / Activate the site / Green usable interactive pedestrian gateway
- Street Performers / Vendors
- Dress up utility box at corner of Granby Street and Charlotte Street / No haphazard look / Consolidate and screen utility infrastructure

Phase 1 Improvements – East End

- Shift terminus of existing knee wall
- Open with Lower Greenery
- Monument or Acknowledgement of the Local Building History
- Seating / Bike Rack / Informational Booth / Kiosk
- Lighting
- Custom Elements that Reflect the Context




