



# Chincoteague Streetscape Enhancement Project

## Public Meeting

March 10, 2009

### COMMENTS / QUESTIONS SUMMARY

- The project will be completed in phases, with the first phase beginning construction in the fall of 09.
- Extend the pavers in the park to meet the honor wall and handicapped access to the library addition
- Provide handicapped parking for the library
- Like the idea of the short term parking/drop off area
- Trolley stops are at Don's Seafood and the laundry mat, the trolley is 116" (9.6 feet) wide
- Like the idea of utilizing the same pavers as those around the Misty statue
- Would like to see a perspective of the Maddox Blvd intersection
- Like the performance stage in the park, the Cultural Alliance offered assistance in its planning when appropriate
- Desire the consolidation and/or removal of the utility poles, if they remain consider attaching the light fixtures to them as previously mentioned
- Consider hanging baskets on light poles
- If loblolly pines are utilized consider a large grouping to minimize wind sway
- Some residences at the north end of Main Street may not want the streetscape trees on their property
- In addition to the Misty statue, individuals are interested in exploring the addition of other elements that exemplify the identity of Chincoteague
- The trolley gives a history tour and would like to use pull off area in front of Misty to stop and discuss the downtown area.
- Take a look at the Phase II Archeological study that was completed by VDOT related to the bridge relocation project #0175-001-V12
- Some on-street parking is desired in the core area as shown, would like the post construction spaces to equal the number of existing spaces
- The library needs parking, don't remove the parking from behind Misty without providing additional parking elsewhere
- Access needs to be provided to the utility parcel adjacent to the existing bridge
