Economic Restructuring & Revitalization

- Undertake activities to identify opportunities to improve the economic and physical conditions within the community
 - Extensive community and stakeholder involvement
 - Analysis / Evaluation (Market Analysis)
 - Establishment of a clear vision and key projects (Economic Restructuring Plan)
 - Implementation Grant Funding up to \$750,000 or \$1,000,000 if housing is included

Invest in Tourism

 \$1 investment in Tourism promotion results in a \$5 impact on local and state taxes - State Tourist Commission

- Improve the aesthetics of the area
- Tools
 - Tax Increment Financing
 - Business Improvement District

- Goal/Projections
 - Increase in tourist traffic of at least 5% / year
 - Over the next 5 years an additional 15,000 20,000 SF new retail space
 - 7,000 10,000 dining
 - 5,000 8,000 specialty retail
 - 2,000 3,000 salon/spa
